

CORSAR & Lake Siskiyou Camp Resort Information

- **Information & Emergency Numbers:**



For any event-related questions, concerns or issues, contact the CORSAR Command Post in person or by radio. NASAR (VSAR16) radio frequency will be monitored at the Command Post/Registration Area from 0700 – 2200 daily.



Incident Command Overhead may be reached directly at 530-598-3487 (Deputy Mike Burns).



For emergencies, dial 911 and notify CORSAR IC Overhead by phone or CP by radio. For on-site non-emergency first aid needs, come to the CP or contact CP by radio. There is an EMT on site.

- Check in time is 3 PM for cabins and 1 PM for campground sites. No noise between 10 PM – 7 AM.
- Name tags are to be worn always unless a safety issue. It is your meal ticket and park entrance pass.
- CORSAR Workshops will begin on the hour and will conclude 15 minutes before the hour.
- No speeding - 15 MPH maximum speed limit; 5 MPH in campgrounds. No skateboards, razor scooters, hoverboards or ATV/OHVs. CORSAR attendees must park all ATVs at the boat parking lot and can NOT ride in the campground areas. For the classes/ride, the participants will meet and leave from the boat parking area as a group out of campground on a designated trail.
- No pets allowed on the beach or eating areas. County ordinance requires all pets to be leashed at all times. Pets are not to be left unattended or locked in cars. No dogs allowed in classrooms except search dogs with official ID. Search dogs may be off leash only if actively engaged in training.
- No fires on the beach including grills. No clotheslines. Park in designated sites or overflow areas. Only two vehicles per camp site. Remember, no alcohol drinking if wearing any official SAR uniform including hats. This is a public campground and your behavior reflects on the image of all SAR.
- One day CA fishing licenses (\$15.69) may be purchased at Solano's 128 Morgan Way, Mt Shasta (south of Black Bear Restaurant in the shopping center).
- This is bear country ... store all food in vehicles out of sight with all windows closed; no storage outside of vehicles at any time, keep site clear of food wrappers, crumbs, empty cans, etc., wash dishes immediately, and be bear aware.
